Park Name: Giant Spruce Park

Key Features: View_Point

Location: Kitimat-Stikine, Terrace, Northern BC - Municipal : Attraction (Heritage Discovery Circle Route)

Description: The Giant Spruce Park offers a trail (85 m) to a 500 year old Sitka Spruce Tree. There is also a secondary short route to a second large Sitka spruce tree approximately halfway to the view of the Giant Spruce. The park has a non-accessible picnic table and an interpretive sign that provides information about the tree. The Park has a gravel parking lot for visitors with no defined parking spaces; no designated accessible parking. The access route to the tree itself is a gravel and dirt route. The route is averagely 1500 mm wide and 1220 at the most narrow spot. Running slope is averagely 2-3 degrees, cross slope is between 1-3 (3 highest slope). The length of the route is approximately 200 metres. The route several spots with groups of rocks protruding higher than 13 mm (approx 20-25 mm). This route would not be recommended for some wheelchairs and persons with certain mobility issues. Persons with good upper body strength may be able to manage the rocky sections of the route.
